TOUR & TASTING: LEIPER'S FORK DISTILLERY

Middle Tennessee has a rich, but nearly forgotten, history of distilling whiskey. The family owned and operated Leiper's Fork Distillery is proud to usher in a new era of distilling in Williamson County. Today, the landscape of distilling locally mimics that of the 1850s, when small batch, locally owned distilleries were producing quality spirits from local ingredients.
